## **Highlights**

Here is just a sampling of the new highimpact outcomes spearheaded by the Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM) that were unveiled at the event:

- The launch of the new Transforming Solar workstream.
- The CEM Action Fund was launched to help turn the CEM communities ambitions into a reality.
- The Announcement of a common Government Fleet Declaration to decarbonise fleets of government owned vehicles.
- CEM and Mission Innovation (MI)

- were named as the future home of the Breakthrough Agenda.
- The launch of a new coalition -Research Impacts on Social Equity and Economic Empowerment (RISE3).
- Governments announce a Green Public Procurement Pledge.
- Publication of the BloombergNEF Energy Transition Factbook.
- CEM members responded in force to President Biden's challenge to mobilize \$90BN in public funding by 2026 for demonstrating clean energy technologies.
